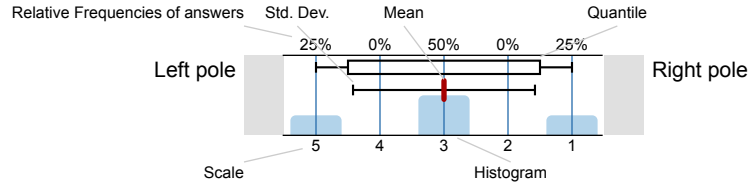

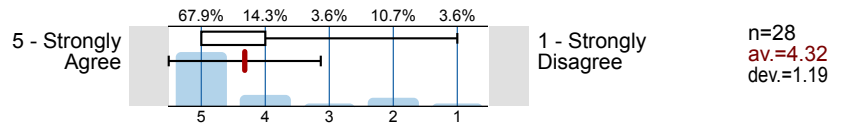

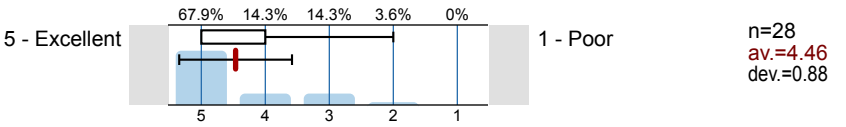

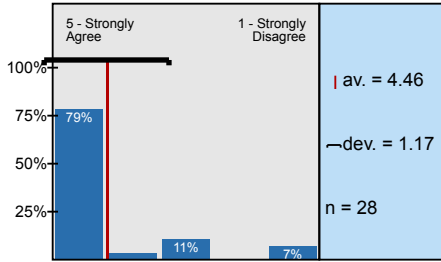

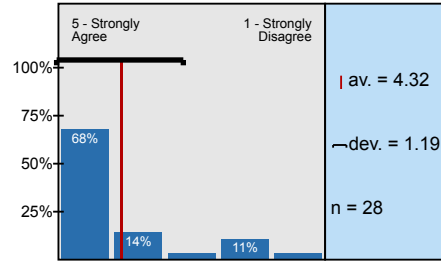


Histogram for scaled questions

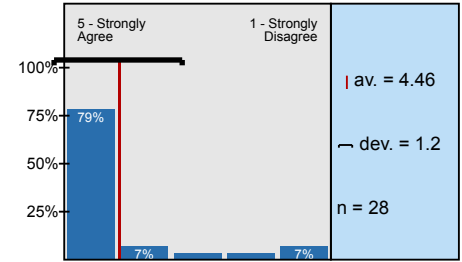
