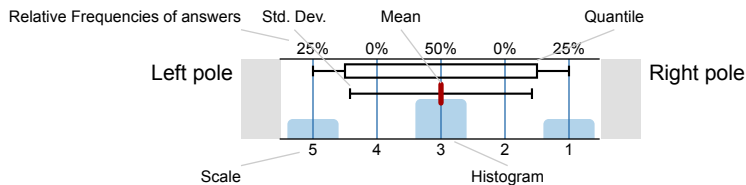

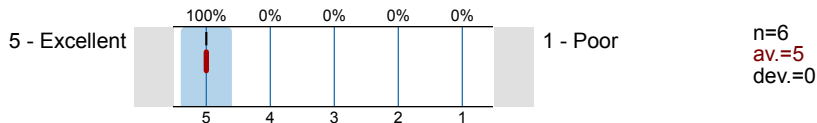

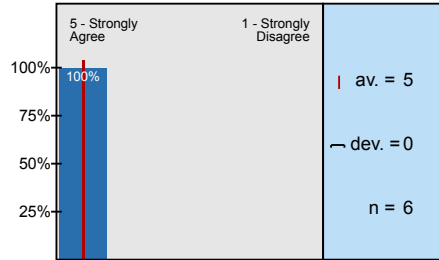


Histogram for scaled questions

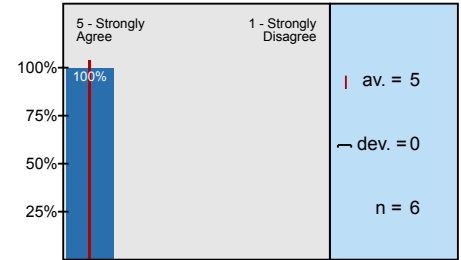

- I enjoyed the fact that we learned about real cutting edge research that is too new to be in textbooks. I liked that in addition to theory, we were also provided with insights into practical laboratory practice and technique.

Hands down the best thing in this course has been inclusion of metal chemistry and EPR!!!! It is so hard to find someone that understands these topics past a textbook level. I have learned more about EPR and its applications from this course than anywhere else combined.

I liked that the instructor was not afraid to state if he disagreed with certain ideas presented in textbooks or research, proceeding to explain why providing examples.

Example of what I have gained from this course:

I synthesize ligands for iron coordination. I now understand why my ligand was designed the way it was, and how it theoretically would react with molecular oxygen. I feel as if I now possess a deeper understanding of enzyme sites and can now see into the theory of ligand design. I no longer just see ligand, I see the intentions of its design. With this I now question ligands, imagining if they were modified and the changes good/bad that would accompany them as well as the ability to probe/observe these changes via EPR.

My previous experience with biochemistry (not this same instructor, a different instructor) left me with a bad impression of the subject, in fact I dreaded taking this course at first. I felt this way because in my previous experience the coursework was 100% memorization with no insight into the chemistry behind what we were memorizing was elucidated and questions of such were quickly dismissed. After taking this course I have realized I love biochemistry, it is such a beautiful subject. I now have the ability to appreciate the complexity of nature on a deeper level, that I may look to chemistry in nature as my guide. It is chemically religious in a sense.

This course facilitated my growth as both a graduate student and researcher, it was much better than I could have ever anticipated.
